PSA Wisconsin Club showcase - Place finish

With 39 UVPC members using the club's Facebook group, the first year demonstrates broad adoption over its first year. The page was created to develop a stronger sense of community among club members - more opportunities to interact as your time permits. Photo sharing is the most common activity. When you're looking at the images, feel free to click the 'Like' button to compliment the maker. Its a simple way to encourage people to keep making pictures, and sharing their experiences. You can also comment on what you like, or ask questions - where it was made, settings, etc. Prior to the Covid-19 problem, we were using the Events tab to organize meet-ups, outings, etc. Impromptu outings posted in the discussion know where other photo ops and gatherings may be happening. For folks who would like some advice and coaching in an area, we just activated the Mentorship capability. Four folks have already been kind enough to offer their services. The online connectivity allows discussion with an easy connection. Watch Party recently came available. This connects people to watch the same video or presentation, such as a webinar. Inside this session, we can share text chat for discussion and commentary. We haven't used this feature yet, but if someone has an idea we'd be glad to give it a go. Remember the UVPC Facebook group is available only to club members. Anyone on Facebook can find the group, but only UVPC members can join to see the content - like showing your work at a club meeting. Looking forward to seeing your images.
